Some of you would know that I myself live with Polycythaemia Vera, one of the Myeloproliferative Neoplasms. MPNs are a little known rare group of progressive blood cancers called 'Myeloproliferative Neoplasms' (MPNs). There is no cure and extremely limited drug therapies. Any person of any age can be affected by a MPN. My goal is to raise funds to contribute toward a research project and to raise awareness to improve the plight of people living with these diseases. I founded a patient volunteer group known as MPN Alliance Australia, working independently under the umbrella of the Leukaemia Foundation of Australia. (Lara Chapman)

In the last few months the MPN AA has been informed by two independent researchers within Australia, that the National Health and Medical Research Council, the largest funding organisation, have declined their applications despite a very positive assessment. We believe that the lack of understanding and awareness of MPN, in combination with lessor numbers of patients, play into this poor outcome.
